Day 1 October 7, Sunday: Depart USA

Today, depart New York's JFK International Airport on EL AL Israel Airlines for our pilgrimage to the Holy Land. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served aloft. (D,B,L)

Day 2 October 8, Monday: Arrive in the Land of the Bible

Arrive at Ben Gurion Tel Aviv Airport, go through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and a Peter's Way Tours tour guide will meet us upon our exit from Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus and soon, we will be on our way to the scenic Mediterranean. **Celebrate Mass at St. Peter's Church in Jaffa.** Continue to our hotel on the beautiful Mediterranean Sea. Check-in and freshen up for dinner. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Netanya. (D)

Day 3 October 9, Tuesday: Caesarea | Mt. Carmel | Nazareth | Cana

Theme: The Annunciation: ...The Word became flesh...(John 1:14). Buffet breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, begin our day with a visit to Caesarea by the Sea, site of a flourishing early Christian community. Visit includes the Theatre, newly excavated Palace, Hippodrome and the Harbor. Continue to Mt. Carmel (*Vineyard of God*) on the Mediterranean coast. Visit Stella Maris, the largest monastery of the Carmelite order, dedicated to the prophet Elijah and Mary, Our Lady of Mount Carmel. It is easy to appreciate the natural beauty of this summit and realize the sanctity associated with it from ancient times to the present. Time will be given for prayer at the Monastery. Proceed to Nazareth for independent lunch. Visit Nazareth, the village in which Jesus grew up and lived most of his life. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Annunciation or the Church of the Holy Family in Nazareth.** After Mass, visit St. Joseph's workshop and explore the magnificent Basilica of the Annunciation, Mary's Well, and the Church of the Old Synagogue. Walk through the streets and imagine a day in the life of the Holy Family of Nazareth, "When they had fulfilled all the prescriptions of the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth. The child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom; and the favor of God was upon him." (Luke 2:39-40). Proceed to Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle. See the display of stone jars and reflect on the miracle of the changing of water into wine. **Couples will have an opportunity to renew their wedding vows.** Continue to the Sea of Galilee, for hotel check-in, dinner and overnight. (B,D)

Day 4 October 10, Wednesday: Caesarea Philippi | Sea of Galilee

Theme: The Ministry of Christ in Galilee Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, drive north to explore the upper regions of Israel to the foot of Mount Hermon, overlooking Syria and the Road to Damascus, where Jesus appeared to Paul. We will visit Caesarea Philippi and reflect in the place where Jesus looked at his disciples and said, "...But who do you say that I am?" (Matthew 16:15). We will reflect here on Peter's response to Jesus, "...You are the Messiah..." (Matthew 16:16). Return to the area around the Sea of Galilee for independent lunch. This afternoon we will visit the ancient city of Capernaum, where Jesus started His ministry. It was here that Jesus found Matthew and called him to discipleship. Jesus worked many of His miracles in Capernaum. Here, the excellent condition of a 2nd century synagogue undoubtedly enclosed the sacred sanctuary in which Jesus taught and preached. Most scholars recognize the home of Peter's mother-in-law in the remains of a church near the shore as dedicated to his honor. At Tabgha, Jesus challenged His disciples to feed a crowd of 5,000 in the Multiplication of Loaves and Fishes. Visit the Church of the Multiplication and the Church of the Primacy. **Celebrate Mass Outdoors at the Church of the Primacy.** Here, after His resurrection, Jesus met with His disciples and told Peter to "feed my lambs; feed my sheep". Continue to visit Mount of the Beatitudes, where Jesus offered His 'Sermon on the Mount.' End our day with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. The Gospels come to life as we imagine when Jesus walked on the water (John 6:19-21), calmed a storm (Matt. 8:23-26), and showed the disciples miraculous catches of fish (Luke 5:1-8; John 21:1-6). Dinner and overnight at hotel by the Sea of Galilee. (B,D)

Day 5 October 11, Thursday: Mt. Tabor | Jericho | Jerusalem

Theme: The Transfiguration Breakfast at hotel. Today's bus journey is filled with variety and excitement. We leave the Sea of Galilee and take a taxi to the top of Mt. Tabor. The elevation provides an utterly commanding view of all of Galilee. It was here that Jesus revealed the wonderful power of presence in communion with Saints of the past (Moses and Elijah). Visit the site of the Transfiguration, with time to reflect on Christ's humanity and Divinity, good preparation for the journey to Jerusalem where Jesus was to suffer the crucifixion and resurrection. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Transfiguration.** Then, continue along the Jordan Valley, Marvel at the desert that is blooming with beautiful flowers, fruits and vegetables. Early afternoon arrive in Jericho for independent lunch. Visit the home of Joshua, Elijah's spring, Jesus' miracles and the Mt. of Temptation. Near the center of the city, a centuries-old sycamore tree recalls the incident in which the tax collector Zacchaeus climbed a sycamore's branches in order to see Jesus. After our visit, we

continue to Jerusalem. En-route, we view the site of Herodian Jericho, the Wadi Quilt and the Monastery of Saints John and George of Coziba. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 6 October 12, Friday: Bethlehem | Shepherds' Field | Mt. Olives | Mt. Zion | Holy Hour of Prayer at Garden of Gethsemane

Themes: Palm Sunday, the Agony in the Garden & the Nativity. Begin our day with a drive to the hills of Bethlehem. Visit Shepherds' Field, where we will see some of the caves, which are typical of the stables of that time. The highlight of our time in Bethlehem will be a visit to the traditional birthplace of Jesus, in the Basilica of the Nativity. Venerate the silver star that marks the place where the sublime mystery of the Incarnation was revealed in a manger! **Celebrate Mass at one of the grotto chapels beneath the Church of the Nativity.** Free time for independent lunch and shopping in Manger Square. After we will drive to the top of Mount of Olives for a magnificent view of the Old City. Visit the Chapel of the Ascension, the Shrine of Pater Noster and the Chapel of *Dominus Flevit* (The Lord Wept). Then, follow Jesus' Palm Sunday route along Hosanna Road to the Garden of Gethsemane. Reflect on Jesus' final night. Visit the Church of All Nations to pray at the "Rock of Agony," a section of bedrock identified as the place where Jesus prayed alone in the garden on the night of His arrest. Continue to visit to the Church of St. Peter-in-Gallicantu. This church is built on the site of the Palace of Caiaphas, the High Priest. Continue to visit the Upper Room, site of the Last Supper and descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles. Then, visit Dormition Abbey, built to honor the Assumption of Our Lady. Dinner at the hotel. **Option to return to the Garden of Gethsemane for a Holy Hour of prayer and Eucharistic Adoration.** Overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 7 October 13, Saturday: Judea | Masada | Qumran | Jordan

Theme: The Wilderness Breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast, we visit Bethany, where Martha, Mary and Lazarus welcomed Jesus in their home. Bethany is also the where the house of Simon the leper was located. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Lazarus.** After Mass, visit the traditional tomb of Lazarus and then drive to Masada, the site of one of Herod's winter palaces and the famous last stand of the Zealots. We will take a cable car, then walk (*climb*) to the tomb and explore the Herodian palaces, water cistern, Roman bath House, storage Houses and Roman siege Camp. Independent lunch. Visit the Dead Sea, and you will have a panoramic view of Ein Gedi, where David hid from Saul's wrath and the locale of the Song of Songs. Later, we will visit Qumran, where the hidden library of the Essenes, the Dead Sea Scrolls (currently displayed at the Israel Museum), were found in 1947. Continue to the Jordan River to visit the traditional site of the baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist (Matthew: 3:13-17). It is also considered to be the place where the Israelites crossed the Jordan River and Elijah the Prophet ascended to heaven. On your return to Jerusalem, pass by the "Inn of the Good Samaritan." Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 8 October 14, Sunday: Temple Mount | Ein Karem

Themes: Early Years in Jerusalem & The Visitation After breakfast, explore the Old City and walk in the area of the Temple Mount, where we can reflect on the Presentation of Jesus at the Temple. Time will be given for prayer at the Western Wall. Above the foundations, we will view the El Aksa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock. Visit the excavation of the Western Wall (*Ophel Hill*). Walking through the narrow alleyways and streets of Jerusalem to see the Pinnacle of the Temple (*Gate of Hulda - after Pentecost, it was here where the disciples preached and baptized*). We will also visit the Jewish Quarter, the Crusader Church of St. Anne and explore the Pool of Bethesda. Independent lunch. Continue to Ein Karem to visit the hometown of Elizabeth and Zachariah, and birthplace of John the Baptist. See the Church of the Visitation, one of the most artistic in the Holy Land. Time will be given for quiet meditation on the meeting between Mary and Elizabeth. Verses from the *Magnificat* are engraved on the columns of the church, and on the wall opposite it are ceramic tablets bearing verses from the *Magnificat* in forty-two different languages. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Visitation.** End our day with a visit to the Israel Museum which houses the Dead Sea Scrolls, important to our understanding and appreciation of the Bible. Explore an enlightening model of the city of Jerusalem as it was in the days of Jesus. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 9 October 15, Monday: Via Dolorosa | Emmaus

Theme: The Crucifixion & The Resurrection Very early morning, drive to the Old City and enter through St. Stephen's Gate. Continue to the chapel of the Flagellation where Jesus was tried and condemned. We will walk and pray the Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa, ending at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. **Celebrate Mass at the Chapel of the Blessed Sacrament in the Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre.** After Mass, we will have a guided tour of the Basilica and return to the hotel for breakfast. Independent lunch. Independent lunch and free time in Jerusalem. This afternoon, visit one of the traditional Emmaus sites where Jesus appeared to His disciples on the road after the Resurrection. **Return to Jerusalem for our group farewell dinner at the Ambassador hotel.** Following dinner, we will have an opportunity to freshen-up before our evening transfer to Tel Aviv Airport for our return flight to the USA. Overnight on our non-stop flight to the USA. (B,D)

Day 10 October 16, Tuesday: Return to the USA

Early morning, arrive in New York's JFK International Airport, overflowing with memories that will change your life.

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or credit/debit card. The package pricing reflects a discount of \$100.00 per person for payments made entirely by personal check, money order or certified bank check. The package price is \$100 higher if paid by credit/debit card. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, there is a \$350.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a nonrefundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are nonrefundable upon receipt. Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline on the brochure.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months, subsequent to return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip economy class from **New York's JFK International Airport on EL AL Israel Airlines.** Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (*approximately 30 days prior to departure*).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the Land Only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (*approximately 30 days prior to departure*). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with private facilities in hotels throughout your tour. Double bedded rooms for married couples are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available for family or friends traveling together. We discourage triple room accommodations because they are usually not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or double bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at booking for an **additional charge of \$650.00**. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be away from the group in hotels. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or on tour), we must charge the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast and dinner daily, including **farewell dinner prior to departure on October 15**. Beverages (coffee, tea, mineral water) are not included at set menu dinners.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work, we recommend \$7.00 per person per day for your tour manager; \$3.00 per person per day for your bus driver. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave \$1.00 per person for the waiters after each meal and \$1.00 per person per day for the maid/bell boys.
