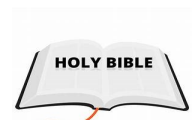

**MESSAGE OF HIS HOLINESS POPE FRANCIS  
FOR LENT 2019**  
*For the creation waits with eager longing  
for the revealing of the children of God (Rm 8: 19)*

*D e a r B r o t h e r s a n d S i s t e r s*

Each year, through Mother Church, God gives us this joyful season when we prepare to celebrate the paschal mystery with mind and heart renewed as we recall the great events that gave us new life in Christ (Pfeffer). We can thus journey from Easter to Easter towards the fulfilment of the salvation we have already received as a result of Christ's paschal mystery – for in hope we were saved (Rm 8:24). This mystery of salvation, already at work in us during our earthly lives, is a dynamic process that also embraces history and all of creation. As Saint Paul says, the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the children of God (Rm 8:19). In this perspective, I would like to offer a few reflections to accompany our journey of conversion this coming Lent.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

Here are some suggestions for this Holy Season at St Therese of Lisieux

**3 Pillars : Pray , Fast and Share**

- 3- Do the Spiritual Works of Mercy
- 4- Do the Corporal works of Mercy

**3- The Seven Penitential Psalms and the Songs of the Suffering Servant**

During times when we wish to express repentance and especially during Lent, it is customary to pray the seven penitential psalms. The penitential designation of these psalms dates from the seventh century. Prayerfully reciting these psalms will help us to recognize our sinfulness, express our sorrow and ask for God's forgiveness. **Psalms 6, 32, 38, 130, 143**

**6- Come to Adore the Lord in the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament every Friday from 9:30 am to 7:00 pm follow by Stations of the Cross every Friday at 7:00 PM**

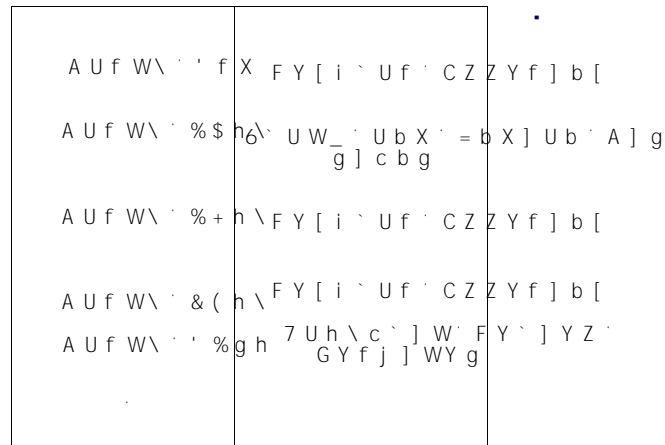

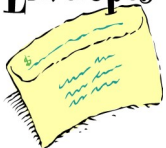
