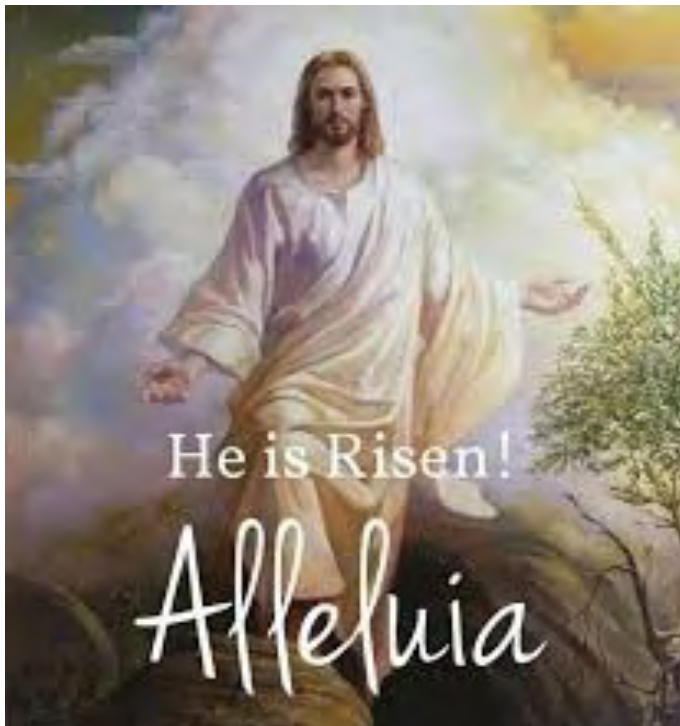

### Sunday school



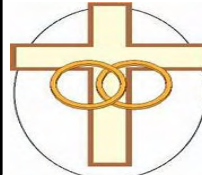
Sunday school provides ongoing religious education and preparation for sacraments.

### Faith Formation RCIA .

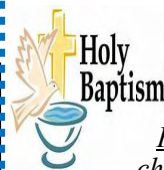
