### Sunday School Registration 2022-23 Class is forming NOW!

Sunday school provides ongoing religious education and preparation for the sacraments. Children attending Public Schools or private schools other than Roman Catholic should attend Sunday school. We have classes from Pre-k on up to the 8th grade. Two consecutive years of instruction are required for the sacraments of Reconciliation and First Eucharist. If you wish your child to receive the sacraments in 2nd grade, they must attend 1st grade. Everyone has to re-register. Registration form is available in back of the Church or at the rectory office.

Registration is \$50 per child, \$75 for two children, and \$100 for 3 or more children.

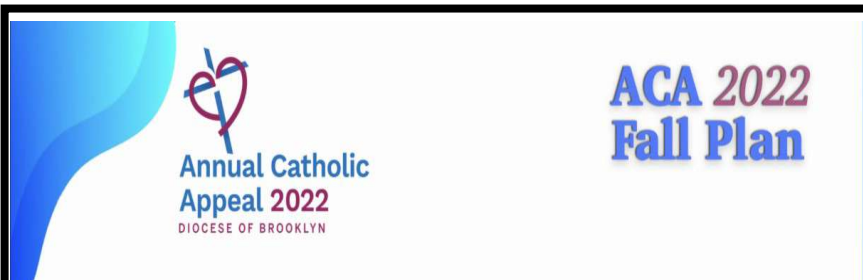

## St. Thérèse of Lisieux



St. Therese of Lisieux Parish was founded on Pentecost Sunday, May 23, 1926 - 93 years ago to serve the growing community of Catholics in East Flatbush Brooklyn. Our Parish consists of over 1000 families. A majority of the members trace their roots to the Caribbean region. The facilities include the St. Catherine of Genoa/St. Therese of Lisieux Academy which serves Pre-K through Jr. High School students.

Our patron saint was born Therese Martin on January 2, 1873 in Alencon, France. She was the last of nine children born to Louis and Zelig Martin. Her mother died when she was 4 years old. Therese was raised by her father who referred to her as his "Little Queen."

At age 14, Therese experienced a life-changing conversion. At age 15 she entered the Carmelite convent in Lisieux fulfilling a life long desire. Upon entering the convent, she took the names St. Therese of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face. Living a life of prayer behind the convent walls, St. Therese developed great intimacy with God. Through prayer based on the Holy Scriptures and hours of meditation before the Blessed Sacrament, St. Therese discovered her "little way", an approach to grow closer to God. After a long struggle with tuberculosis, St. Therese died on September 30, 1897 at the early age of 24

After her death, St. Therese quickly gained popularity among the faithful. She was canonized by Pope Pius XI on May 17, 1925. On October 19, 1997, Pope John Paul II declared her a Doctor of the Church. St. Therese, also known as the Little Flower, is referred to as the "greatest saint of modern times".

## St. Thérèse de Lisieux

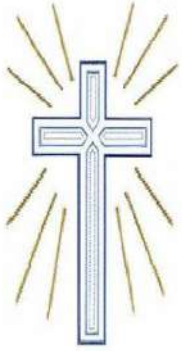
La paroisse Sainte-Thérèse de Lisieux a été fondée le 23 mai 1926 (dimanche de la Pentecôte), cela fait 93 ans, pour servir la communauté grandissante de catholiques d'East Flatbush Brooklyn. Notre paroisse compte plus de 1000 familles. La majorité des membres sont originaires de la région des Caraïbes.

Sainte Thérèse de l'Enfant Jésus et de la Sainte Face, plus connue sous le nom Sainte Thérèse de Lisieux (Alençon, 2 janvier 1873, Lisieux, 30 septembre 1897) est une soeur carmélite morte de la tuberculose en 1897 à l'âge de 24 ans. Laissant une relation littéraire de ses expériences mystiques, elle est canonisée en 1925, puis proclamée sainte patronne secondaire de la France et Docteur de l'Église.

Thérèse de Lisieux attire des millions de croyants et de non-croyants du monde entier, ses reliques parcourent les cinq continents, deux mille églises lui sont aujourd'hui dédiées à travers le monde et ses écrits sont parmi les textes les plus traduits. En 1927, elle est proclamée patronne principale de tous les missionnaires et des missions existant dans le monde entier.

Thérèse a su placer une foi et une espérance inébranlables en la force de la prière, osant tout demander à Dieu. Pour elle, nul objet de prière n'est trop grand ni trop petit.

Cette prière incessante, infatigable, cette prière fidèle au monde, Thérèse nous l'a promise au-delà de la mort : "Je passerai mon ciel à faire du bien sur la terre".

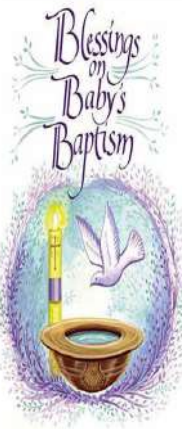
