To have your child receive the Sacrament of Baptism at least one parent and one godparent must be Catholic. For registration, parents must bring a copy of the child's Birth Certificate to the rectory.

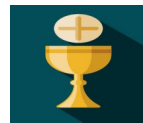

Prayer and the sacraments are central to our Catholic Faith. The priests of our parish offer the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick at the noon mass on the First Saturday of every month. In the case of brothers or sisters who are seriously ill or facing medical procedures, as well as those who are in danger of death, family members can reach out to the rectory at (718) 451-1500 to request a visit either to the home or hospital by one of our priests.



For our brothers or sisters who have crossed over, family members can request that their deceased loved ones be enrolled in the parish Purgatorial Society where the deceased will be included in the 12:00pm mass intentions on the First Saturday of the month for one year. The suggested donation for the mass card and intention is \$15.
