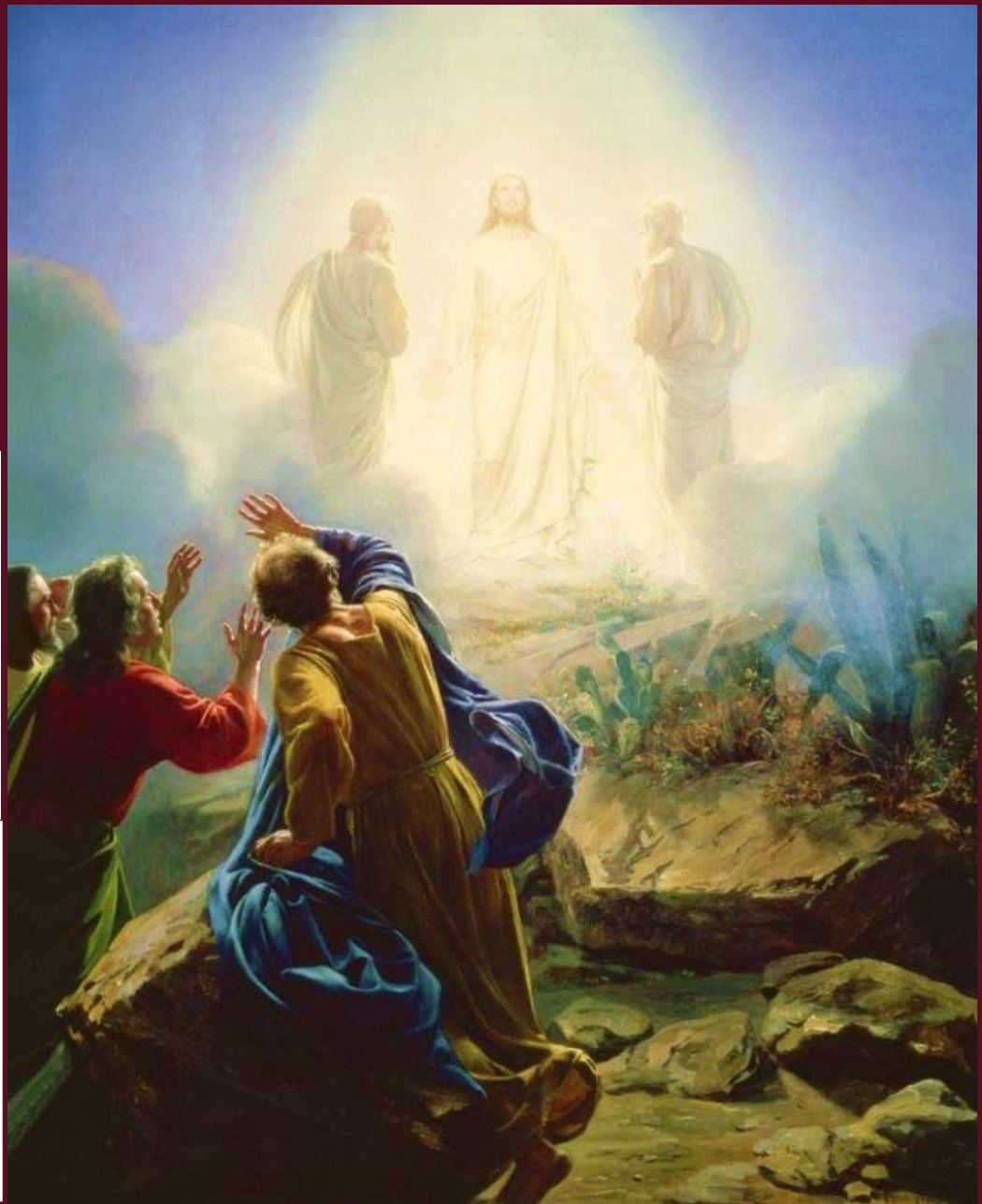

Prayer and the sacraments are central to our Catholic Faith. The priests of our parish offer the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick at the noon mass on the First Saturday of every month. For our brothers or sisters who have crossed over, family members can request that their deceased loved ones be enrolled in the parish "Purgatorial Society" where the deceased will be included in the 12:00pm mass intentions on the First Saturday of the month for one year. The suggested donation for the mass card and intention is \$15.

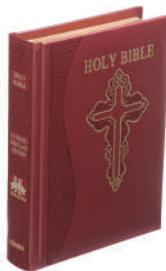
