- ④ —752 East 46th Street

- 1- Leaving the Church of St. Therese of Lisieux, 4402 Ave. D. we will Head East on Ave D 4524 Ave D the first stop of the procession of the Repository.
- 2- Then from 4524 Ave D we will turn Left onto Schenectady Ave. 1209 Schenectady Ave to the second stop of the procession of the Repository.
- 3- Then from 1209 Schenectady Ave, we will head North on Schenectady Ave. Turn Right onto Clarendon Rd
- 4703 Clarendon Rd to the Third stop of the procession of the Repository.
- 4- From 4703 Clarendon Rd, we will head West on Clarendon Rd. Turn Left onto E 46th Street. 752 E 46th Street to the Fourth stop of the procession of the Repository
- 5- Returning to the Church, Head South on E 46th Street. Turn Right on Ave D. Then turn Left on Troy Ave. 4402 Ave D
