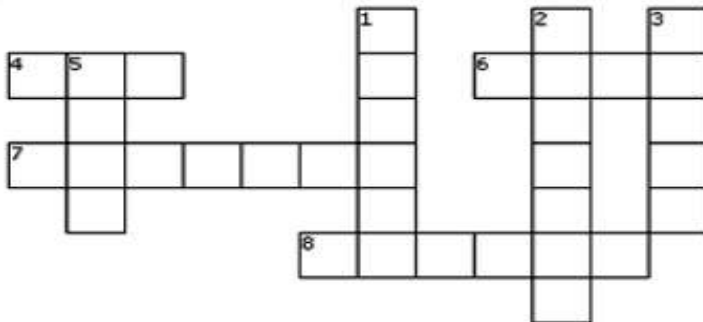
PENTECOST VIGIL MASS
