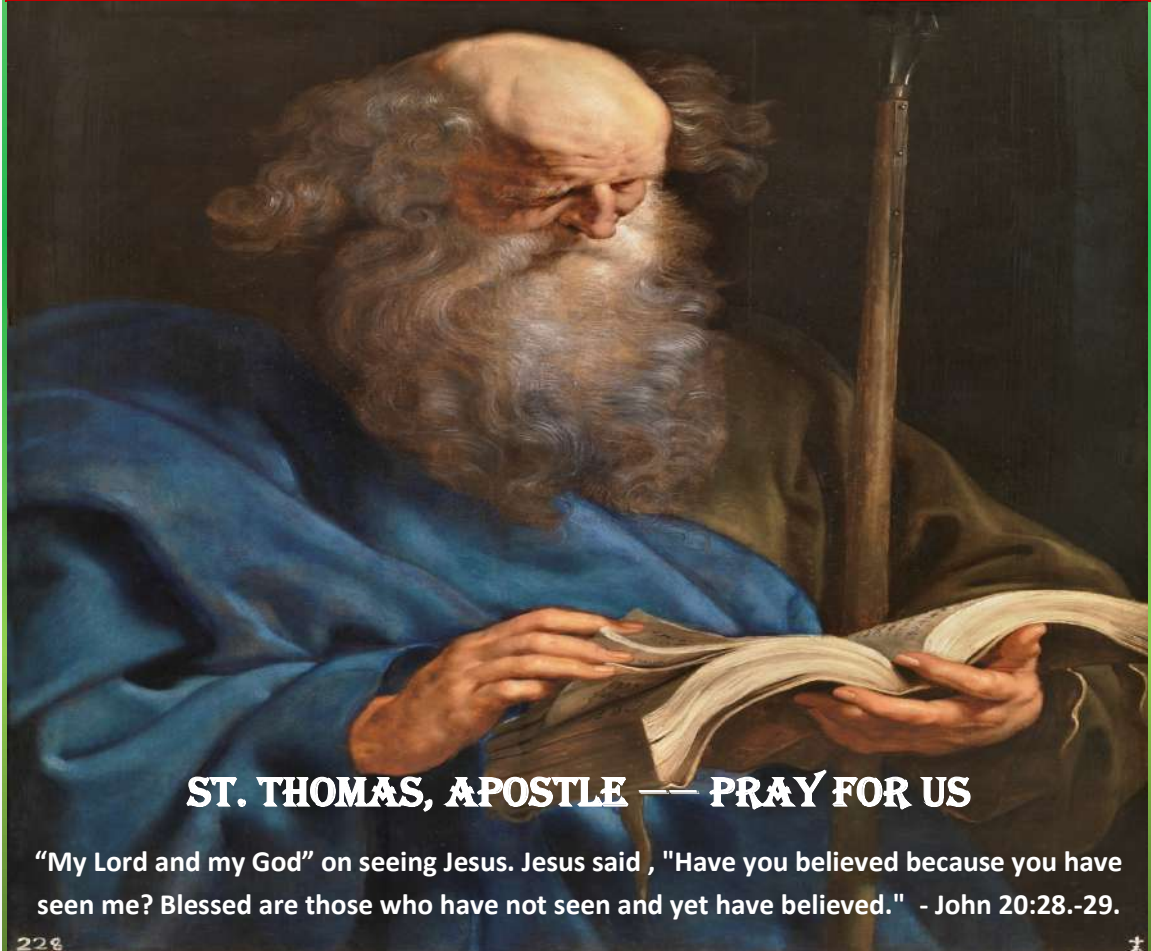

Thomas, he requested physical proof of the Resurrection, fulfilled when Christ reappeared and specifically asked Thomas to touch his wounds. His sudden realization of truth (“My Lord and my God”) made Thomas the first person to explicitly acknowledge Jesus’ divinity. The phrase “doubting Thomas” was coined for his lack of faith. He is regarded as the patron saint of India among its Christian adherents, and the **Feast of Saint Thomas on July 3** is celebrated as Indian Christians' Day.

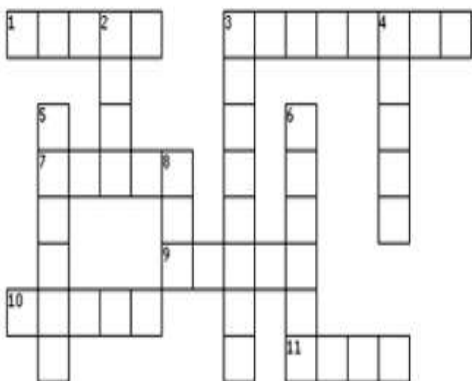
