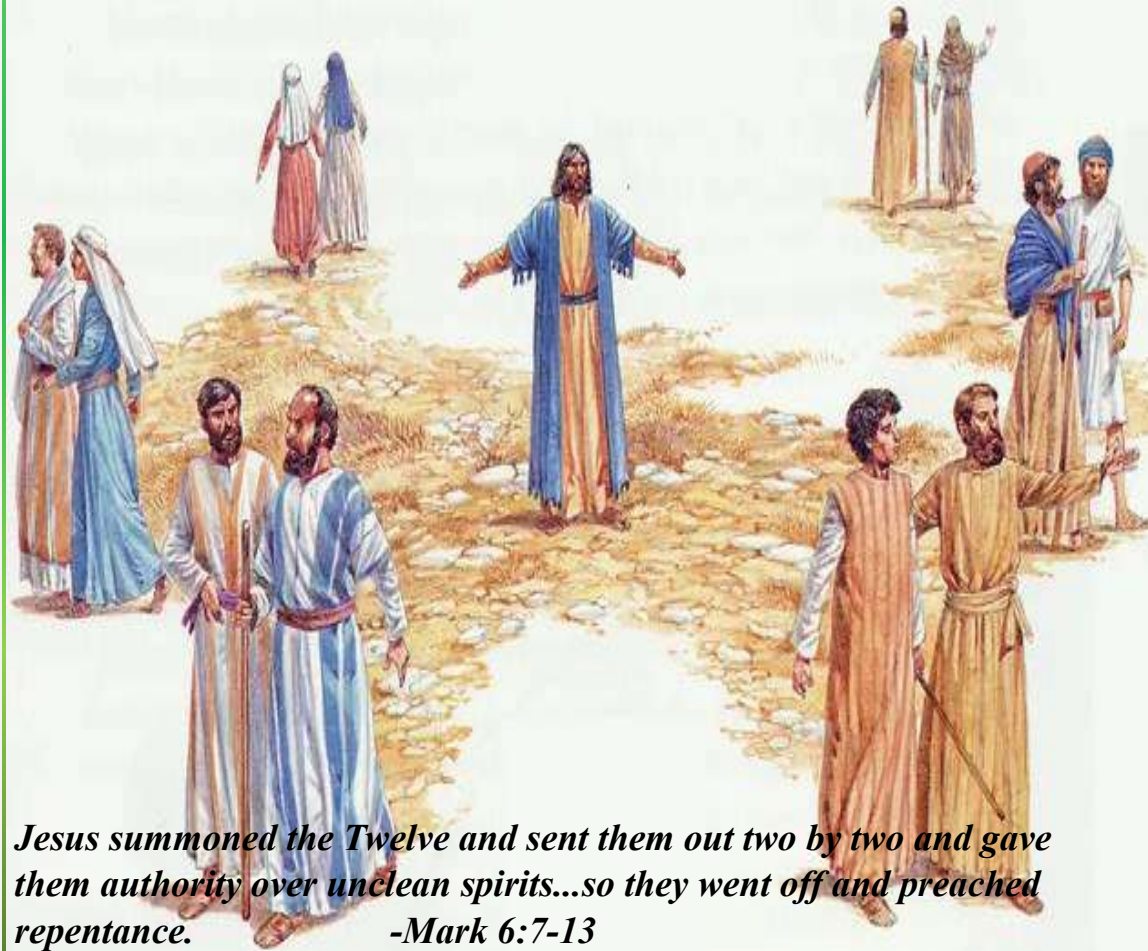

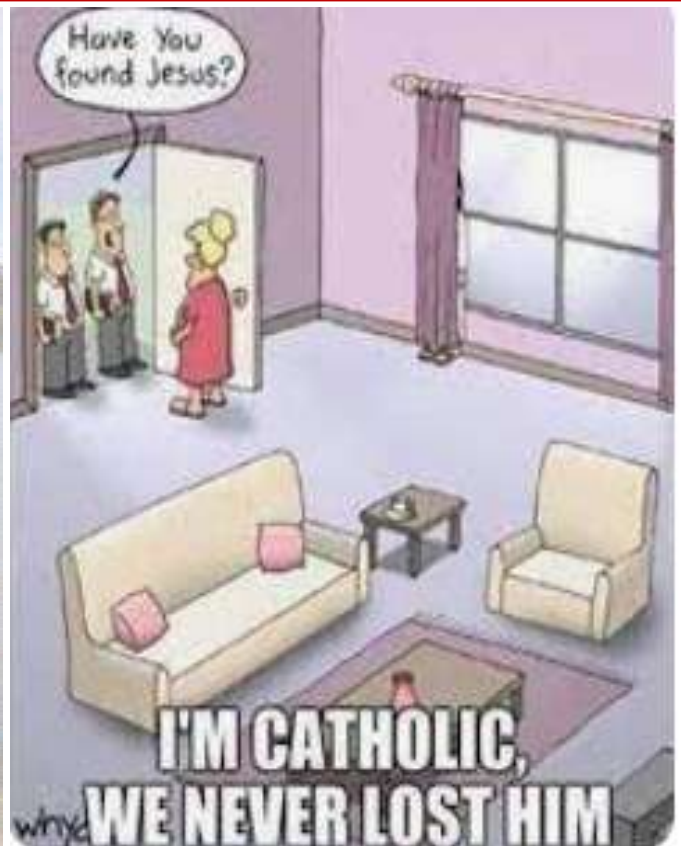
### Prayer For Hurricane Season

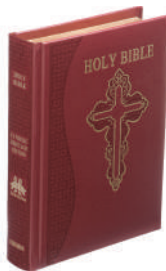
