Therefore, let us be alert, prepared, and ready to celebrate these important milestones!



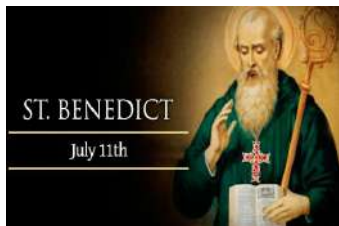

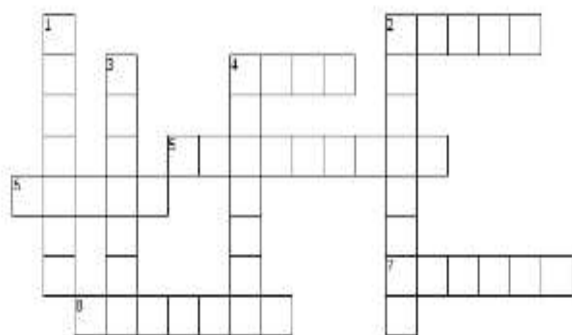
